



Confidential Declaration by proposed Junior Coach/Leader

1. You are requested to complete the enclosed Declaration and to return it to the Club's Child Welfare Person (Mike Buckley)
2. Under the provisions relating to work with children and young people in the Rehabilitation of Offenders (Exceptions) Order 1975, you are not entitled to withhold information about convictions which for other purposes are "spent" under the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974. You are required to provide such information in relation to any offence which is within Schedule 1 to the Children and Young Persons Act 1933 or the Schedule to the Disqualification for Caring for Children Regulations 1991 and certain other serious sexual offences.
3. The information will be treated as strictly confidential. It will be seen only by the Club's Child Welfare Person and the Chairman of the Club and no information in it will be disclosed except where there is a legal duty to do so or the Club receives legal advice that disclosure ought to take place in order to ensure the protection of children.
4. The Club's Child Welfare Person may carry out a police check.
5. You are now asked to complete the Declaration and return it to the Club's Child Welfare Person.
